Dauan, the smallest island in the Top Western Cluster, is situated approximately 6 km to the south west of Saibai. It is also known as Mount Cornwallis Island, and incidentally forms part of the Great Dividing Range. The language spoken on Dauan is Kalaw Kawaw Ya, and there are strong traditional kinship ties with the other Top Western Cluster islands of Saibai and Boigu. Dauan is serviced by boat, barge and helicopter, the nearest airport being Saibai.
