*Integrated Planning Act 1997***ADOPTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE PLANNING SCHEME FOR THE CITY OF LOGAN**

Notice is given under the *Integrated Planning Act 1997*, schedule 1 that on 10 May 2011 Council adopted an amendment to the Logan Planning Scheme 2006. The amendment will have effect on and from 11 June 2011.

The purpose and general effect of the planning scheme amendments are to:

- Include part of the M5 sub-area of the Marsden/Kingston zone located east of Meakin Road, Kingston - in the proposed M10 sub-area of the Marsden/Kingston zone;
- Specify revised outcomes for part of the S5 sub-area of the Springwood zone located to the south-east of Old Chatswood Road, Daisy Hill; and
- Clarify the operation of gross leasable area qualifiers in the relevant assessment tables and codes.

**NOTICE OF ADOPTED SUBORDINATE LOCAL LAWS TORRES STRAIT ISLAND REGIONAL COUNCIL**

At its Ordinary Meeting held at Badu Island on 18 May 2011, Council resolved to adopt the following Subordinate Local Laws to compliment the already adopted Model Local Laws: -

**1. Subordinate Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2011**

*Provides a legal and procedural framework for the administration, implementation and enforcement of local government local laws, subordinate local laws and specified regulatory powers under legislation, and to provide for miscellaneous administrative matters such as application processes for specified prescribed activities.*

Authorising Law: Model Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2010

**2. Subordinate Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2011**

*Regulates and manages the keeping and control of animals in the local government area.*

Authorising Law: Model Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2010

**3. Subordinate Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2011**

*Protects the environment and public health, safety and amenity within the local government area.*

Authorising Law: Model Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2010

**4. Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011**

*Protects the health and safety of persons using local government controlled areas, facilities, infrastructure and roads and preserves features of the natural and built environment and other aspects of the amenity of local government controlled land, facilities, infrastructure and roads.*

Authorising Law: Model Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2010

**5. Subordinate Local Law No. 7 (Indigenous Community Land Management) 2011.**

*Enables the local government to regulate Reserve and Deed of Grant in Trust land including who may enter, be in or live in, the trust area, the management of camping sites and the designation and regulation of parks and reserves on trust land.*
