### SAIBAI MECHANICS SHED W4Q ROUND 5 – LOT AMALGAMATION

#### **OFFICER RECOMMENDATION:**

#### Council (as Trustee):

- a) notes that the new Saibai Mechanics Shed is funded under W4Q Round 5;
- b) consents to the registration of Survey Plan SP354947, which provides for the amalgamation of lots 34 and 35 on SP267944 into one lot, being lot 345 on SP354947, for the purposes of realigning land boundaries for the construction of the new shed; and
- c) delegates to the Chief Executive Officer and the Mayor, the power to sign the Titles Form 18A (Registered Owner consent to a survey plan).

#### **Executive Summary:**

The purpose of this report is to seek approval from the Trustee to amalgamate Lots 34 and 35 on SP267944 into one lot, being lot 345 on SP354947, for the purposes of realigning land boundaries on Saibai for the construction of the new Mechanics Shed.

#### **Background**

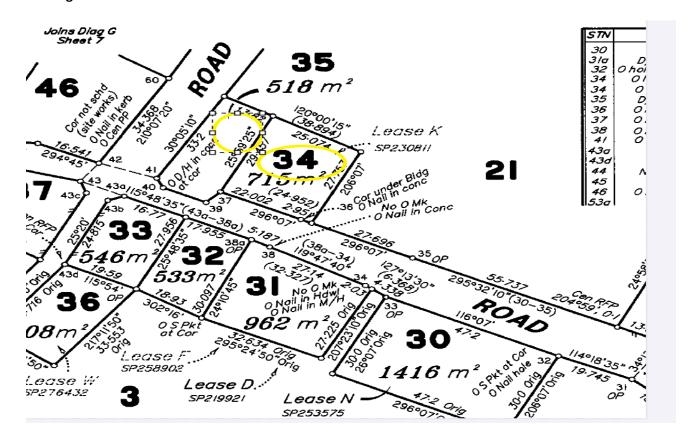
The Saibai Mechanics shed is scheduled to be replaced as part of the W4Q projects. The project is currently out to tender with a proposed construction date of June 2026. A concept design of the new shed is shown at Attachment 1.

The project includes demolition of the existing sheds and associated infrastructure that are situated within lots 34 and 35 on SP267944 (School Road). The existing buildings are a double shed on lot 34 and a single shed on lot 35.

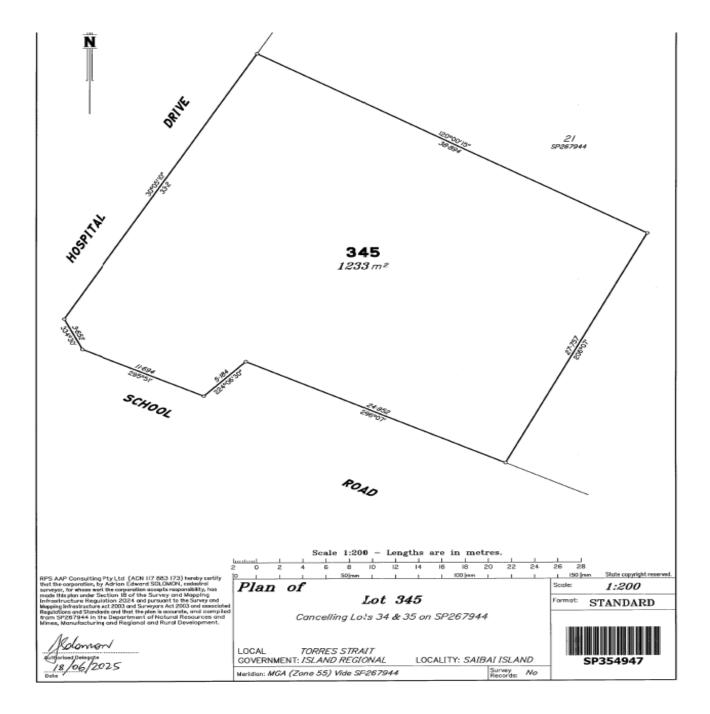
The new design is one large shed which includes a staff room and amenities, a tool lock- up area, workbenches and a workshop. To suit the new layout and for better placement of the building, it is proposed to amalgamate lots 34 and 35 together to create one lot (lot 345). From a town planning and land tenure perspective, it is best to have the new shed situated within one lot.

Trustee consent to the lot amalgamation and registration of the survey plan is required.

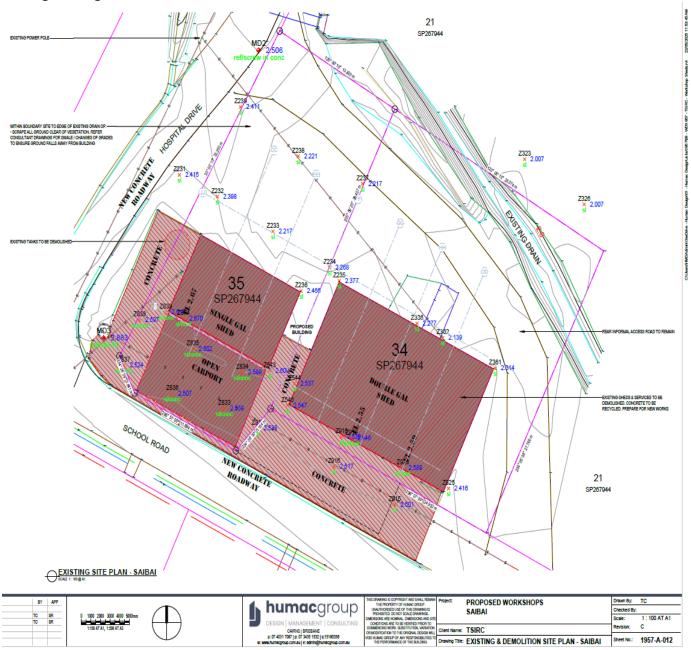
#### Existing lots 34 and 35



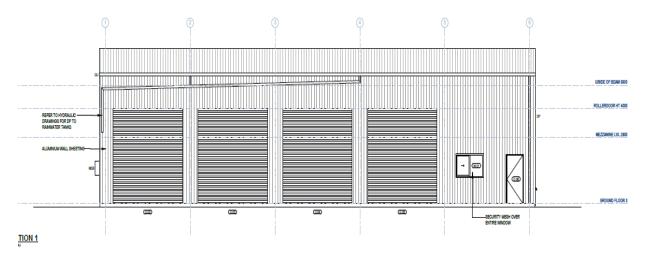


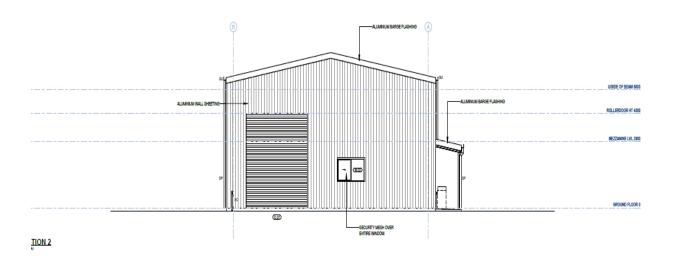


# Existing buildings to be demolished within lot 34 and 35

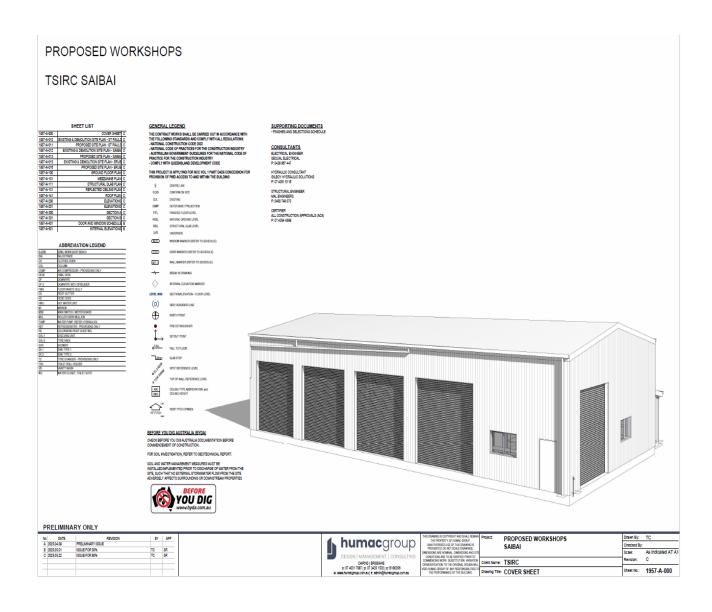


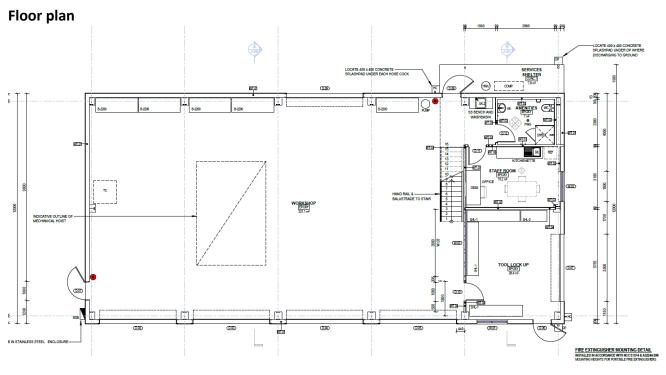
# Concept design new building within lot 345



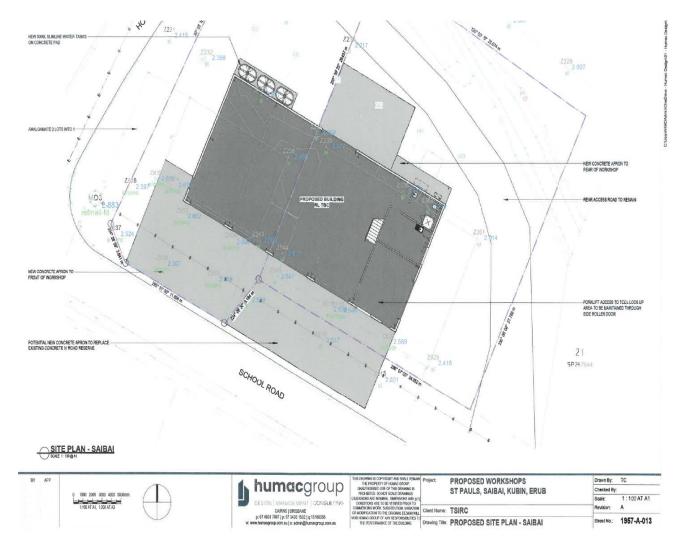

#### Additional information.

In accordance with the *Planning Act 2016* and the *Land Title Act 1994*, Planning Body approval from Council in its capacity as Local Government is not required for a plan of amalgamation. The Land Title Act allows the Registrar of Titles to create one indefeasible title for the amalgamated lots, where the lots share a common boundary.

The lot amalgamation does not require Native Title consent, however construction of the new shed does. Therefore, Native Title consent will be sought from the Saibai Mura Buway PBC prior to construction.
